Golf Tournament

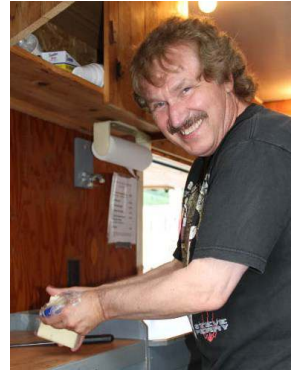

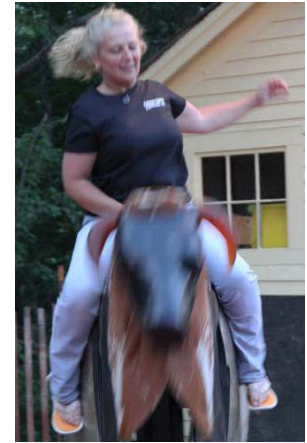
