This is our biggest fundraiser so let's make this a great success! Sign-up sheets will be passed around at the May 18th meeting

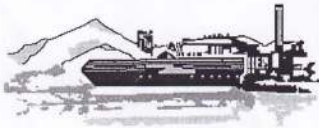
Colebrook Kiwanis Receives \$150 Donation




