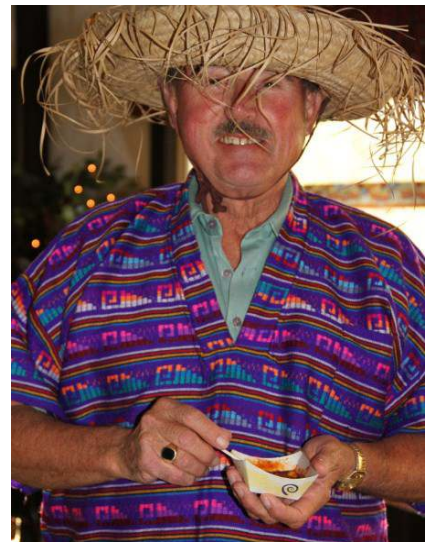

Dr. John Fothergill from Indian Stream Health Center was this week's guest speaker. Dr. Fothergill discussed The Rec Center.
