Make-up Credits For Missed Meetings

Did you ever wonder how a member can have perfect attendance and not attend club meetings? There are 13 ways that members can earn make-up credits for missed club meetings. According the KI Policy, 1 credit shall be given for personal attendance at the following meetings or activities during the calendar month or seven (7) days immediate preceding or following the month that a club meeting is missed:

1. A regular meeting of any Kiwanis Club.
2. A round table meeting.
3. A special meeting of a Kiwanis Club.
4. A regular meeting of the member's club Board of Directors.
5. A regular, scheduled meeting of a formally established committee of the members' club.
6. Participate in a club approved service project. (Maximum of 1 credit per day per service project.)
7. Attendance at an International, district, or division convention, conference, or formally scheduled meeting. (Maximum of 1 credit per convention, conference, or meeting, regardless of length.)
8. Attendance at in International or district board meeting. (Maximum of 1 credit per meeting, regardless of length.)
9. Absence from a regular club meeting as a result of travel to or from the International or district convention or conference. (Travel must be within 7 days before and/or after the convention or conference.)
10. Attendance at any club function for Kiwanians and their families designed to improve district health, welfare, morale, and esprit de corps (club dinners, picnics, birthday parties, outings, etc.). (Maximum of 1 credit per month.)
11. Attendance at any club sponsored programs board meeting, regular meeting or sponsored programs service project.
12. A visit to the Kiwanis International Office, a Regional Service Center, or a district office. (Maximum of 1 credit per quarter.)
13. On credit shall be given for each regular meeting missed as a result of performing Jury duty.
