NH Electric Coop representative Seth Wheeler was the guest speaker at last week's meeting. Seth discussed the company's upcoming plans to upgrade to a new metering system. The meters will be installed over the next two year. The new meters will report their own readings to send readings to relays located in the area. The readings will then be sent from a tower on Mudget Mountain to Mount Washington and then to corporate headquarters in Plymouth. The new system is expected to save the company about \$1 million a year in operating costs.
